"Petitioner's income" shall include bonuses, capital gains income, tax free income, income available from matured stock options, whether or not exercised, etc. Said bonus support shall be payable by Petitioner within 15 days of receipt of said bonus money by Petitioner.


- 3. Child Support Termination and Reductions. The payments specified in Section 2 cease to be due for the child on the first to occur of the following events: Child dies, Respondent dies and Petitioner assumes custody, the child is emancipated, or the child reaches the age of 18 (except that an unemancipated 18-year-old unmarried child, who is a full-time high school student and is not self-supporting, shall be entitled to continued support until the completion of the 12th grade or attaining the age of 19, whichever first occurs).
- 4. Additions to Child Support. In addition to the child support set forth above, the following amounts shall be paid (as provided below) to Respondent as part of the regular monthly allotment of child support from Petitioner:
  - (A) <u>Child Care Costs Related to Employment/Training</u>. Each of the Parties will pay one half of the cost of child's child care related to employment, education and/or training for employment. The Court shall reserve jurisdiction to resolve disputes between the Parties related to this provision.
- (B) <u>Unreimbursed Health-Care Expenses</u>. Each of the Parties will pay one half of the cost of all of the child's health care expenses that aren't reimbursed by health insurers. Neither party will unreasonably withhold consent to a health-care expense recommended by a licensed physician. The Court shall reserve jurisdiction to resolve disputes between the Parties related to this provision.
- 5. Procedures for Reimbursement of Add-On Expenses. The additional child support expenses enumerated in Section 4 above shall be handled by the Parties per the attached Notice of Rights and Responsibilities.
- 6. Attachment of Support Assumptions. As required by law, attached hereto as Exhibit  $\underline{A}$  is the parties' proposed DissoMaster (TM) support calculation setting forth their assumptions with regard to gross income, tax filing status, time-share, add-on expenses, and any other factor relevant to the support calculation. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is the parties's proposed

#### **NOTICE OF RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Health-Care Costs and Reimbursement Procedures**

If you have a child support order that includes a provision for the reimbursement of a portion of the child's or children's health-care costs and those costs are not paid by insurance, the <u>law savs</u>:

- Notice. You must give the other parent an itemized statement of the charges that have been billed for any healthcare costs not paid by insurance. You must give this statement to the other parent within a reasonable time, but no more than 30 days after those costs were given to you.
- 2. Proof of full payment. If you have already paid all of the uninsured costs, you must (1) give the other parent proof that you paid them and (2) ask for reimbursement for the other parent's court-ordered share of those costs.
- 3. Proof of partial payment. If you have paid only your share of the uninsured costs, you must (1) give the other parent proof that you paid your share, (2) ask that the other parent pay his or her share of the costs directly to the health-care provider, and (3) give the other parent the information necessary for that parent to be able to pay the bill.
- 4. Payment by notified parent. If you receive notice from a parent that an uninsured health-care cost has been incurred, you must pay your share of that cost within the time the court orders; or if the court has not specified a period of time, you must make payment (1) within 30 days from the time you were given notice of the amount due, (2) according to any payment schedule set by the health-care provider, (3) according to a schedule agreed to in writing by you and the other parent, or (4) according to a schedule adopted by the court.
- 5. Going to court. Sometimes parents get into disagreements about health-care costs. If you and the other parent cannot resolve the situation after talking about it, you can request that the court make a decision.
- Disputed charges. If you dispute a charge made by the other parent, you may file a request for the court to resolve the dispute, but only if you pay that charge before filing your request.

- b. Nonpayment. If you claim that the other parent has failed to pay you back for a payment, or they have failed to make a payment to the provider after proper notice, you may file a request for the court to resolve the dispute. The court will presume that if uninsured costs have been paid, those costs were reasonable.
- Attorney's fees. If the court decides one parent has been unreasonable, it can order that parent to pay the other parent's attorney's fees and costs.
- d. Court forms. Use forms <u>FL-300</u> and <u>FL-480</u> to get a court date. See form <u>FL-300-INFO</u> for information about completing, filling, and serving your court papers.
- 6. Court-ordered insurance coverage. If a parent provides health-care insurance as ordered by the court, that insurance must be used at all times to the extent that it is available for health-care costs.
- a. Burden to prove. The parent claiming that the coverage is inadequate to meet the child's needs has the burden of proving that to the court.
- b. Cost of additional coverage. If a parent purchases health-care insurance in addition to that ordered by the court, that parent must pay all the costs of the additional coverage. In addition, if a parent uses alternative coverage that costs more than the coverage provided by court order, that parent must pay the difference.
- 7. Preferred health providers. If the court-ordered coverage designates a preferred health-care provider, that provider must be used at all times consistent with the terms of the health insurance policy. When any parent uses a health-care provider other than the preferred provider, any health-care costs that would have been paid by the preferred health provider if that provider had been used must be the sole responsibility of the parent incurring those costs.

# Information About Child Support for Incarcerated or Detained Parents

- 1. Child support. Under current California law, child support ordered or changed after December 31, 2020, automatically stops if the parent who has to pay
- Is confined against their will for more than 90 days in a row in jail, prison, juvenile detention, a mental health facility, or other institution.
- 2. Exceptions. Child support does not automatically stop if the parent who has to pay
- is confined for
  - o domestic violence against the other parent or child, or
  - o falling to pay a child support order; or
- has money available to pay child support.

- 3. Timing. Child support will automatically restart at the old amount the first day of the first full month after the parent is released. If you need to change your child support order, see page 2.
- 4. Past confinement. If your child support order was entered or modified between October 8, 2016, and December 31, 2019, and you were confined against your will for more than 80 days in a row during the same time frame, you may also qualify for relief. See item 5 for how to obtain more information.
